Agnes Scott Alumni Ireland & Scotland Tour

June 2nd - 15th, 2018

Day 1 – June 2nd - Saturday: U.S. to Ireland: Depart the U.S. for your overnight flight to Ireland. Dinner will be served shortly after take-off.

Day 2 – June 3rd - Sunday: Dublin – Belfast: Morning arrival at Dublin Airport. After clearing Irish customs, you'll board your motor coach and travel a short distance to the **Man of War Pub**, where you'll enjoy your first Irish breakfast. Continue on then to Belfast City, where you check into your hotel. Take a stroll around the neighborhood or catch a nap before you gather for dinner at your hotel. Overnight at the **Malone Lodge**.

Day 3 – June 4th - Monday: Belfast: This morning after breakfast at your hotel, enjoy a guided sightseeing tour of Belfast with Fiona O'Donovan visiting sites of cultural significance. After lunch on your own in the city centre, we'll make our way to R-City Coffee (432 Crumlin Rd.); a café located where a protestant and a Catholic neighborhood meet that is designed with two entrance doors so that people from both communities can enter and feel welcome. We'll have a coffee and hear about the work R-City does with young people from both communities. Dinner on your own and overnight at the Malone Lodge.

Day 4 – June 5th – Tuesday: Belfast: This morning there will be a Coiste panel (former paramilitaries) about life since The Troubles at your hotel from 9:30am – 11:30am. Lunch today is at the Ulster Scots Agency at 1:00 and includes a lecture on the Ulster Scots language and culture. At 3:30 we'll visit with Linda Ervine of Turas at East Belfast Mission, Skainos Centre; Linda teaches the Gaelic language in a Unionist-Loyalist community. Tonight you will enjoy "Lovers: Winners & Losers" at the Lyric Theatre at 7:45pm. Dinner on your own and overnight at the Malone Lodge.

Day 5 – June 6th – Wednesday: Belfast: Today you have the option of going for a scenic drive along the Antrim Coast or taking the day to independently explore Belfast City. Tonight author Anne Devlin will give a talk at our hotel at 7:30. Dinner on your own and overnight at Malone Lodge.

Day 6 – June 7th – Thursday: Belfast – Cairnryan – Maybole – Ayr: This morning after breakfast you'll bid a fond farewell to your Irish driver/guide Dave. You will then be met by your Scottish tour escort, Joe Clifford and be escorted to your new coach for the Scottish portion of your trip and transfer to Larne Pier for the ferry to Cairnryan. On to Maybole for a guided visit of Culzeon Castle and Country Park. Dinner on your own and overnight at the Western House Hotel in Ayr.

Day 7 – June 8th – Friday: Ayr – Alloway – Ayr: After a full Scottish Breakfast at the hotel, you travel on to Alloway to visit the **Robert Burns Birthplace Centre** for a guided tour. Lunch on you own at the Centre. Your afternoon is free to explore Ayr. Dinner on your own and overnight at **Western House Hotel**.

Day 8 – June 9th – Saturday: Ayr – Dumfries – Melrose: After breakfast, you make your way to Dumfries, stopping at the Ellisland Farm for the "Tam O'Shanter Walk" and recitation. Enjoy lunch at the farm (soup, sandwich and coffee). In Dumfries you view the Globe Inn and stop at Robert Burn's House and tomb. On to Melrose. Dinner on your own and overnight at Burt's Hotel and Town House Hotel.

Day 9 – June 10th – Sunday: Melrose: Breakfast at hotel, then off to **Abbotsford House and Gardens**, Sir Walter Scott's house, for a guided tour and lunch on your own. After, visit **Dryburgh Abbey**, Scott's burial place, and other related sites with a local guide. Dinner on your own and overnight at **Burt's Hotel and Town House Hotel.**

Day 10 – June 11th – Monday: Melrose – Selkirk – Melrose: After breakfast at your hotel, you travel on to Selkirk and visit the Bowhill House Country Estate for a guided tour. Then on for a tour of the Locharron Visitor Centre, where you will also enjoy a lunch of soup and sandwich. Enjoy a guided tour of the Locharron Mill before returning to your Melrose hotel. Tonight we have a three course dinner with a Scottish musical performance at the Townhouse Hotel. Overnight at Burt's Hotel and Town House Hotel.

Day 11 – June 12th – Tuesday: Melrose – Roslin – South Queensferry – Loch Lomond: After breakfast at your hotel, you will head to Rosslyn Chapel, a place of worship since 1446, for a guided tour. Then on to South Queensferry, a historic village on Firth of Forth where three Forth bridges meet. Here you will have time to explore the many cafes, shops, and sights of the town including Hawes Inn, and have lunch on your own. Dinner on your own and overnight at The Lodge Hotel in Loch Lomond.

Day 12 – June 13th – Wednesday: Loch Lomond: Full English breakfast in hotel. You will then enjoy a 90 minute scenic **cruise on Loch Lomond** including tea and shortbread. The rest of the day is at your leisure, or take an excursion to **Trossachs**. Three course **dinner** and overnight at **The Lodge Hotel**.

Day 13 – June 14th – Thursday: Loch Lomond – Edinburgh: After your hotel breakfast, you will head to Edinburgh where you will meet your local city guide and embark on a "**Book Lovers Tour**" exploring significant literary sites. A stop is included at the café where J.K. Rowling wrote the early chapters of the first Harry Potter novel. Dinner will be on your own. Overnight at **Edinburgh Marriott Hotel.**

Day 14 – June 15th – **Friday:** After breakfast, you will transfer to the Edinburgh airport to head home or continue your travels. U.S. flights arrive home the same day.
